<u>Novice</u>

The top four scoring novice dogs from the first round will compete in the final and we offer:

First: \$100, perpetual trophy, trophy to keep, embroidered dog rug and a bag of Dogpro PlusSecond: \$50, trophy and a bag of Dogpro PlusThird: \$25, trophy and a bag of Dogpro Plus

Entry fee is \$10 per dog.

Junior handlers' event

A Junior handler's event will be held during the lunch breaks for competitors under the age of 21 as of January 1, 2024.

First: Trophy and a bag of Dogpro Plus Second: trophy and a bag of Dogpro Plus

Entry fee is \$5 per dog.

State Championships

Judge: Merv Simmonds, South Australia

The State Championships will follow after the conclusion of the Novice final. This is an open event only, however, novice and improver dogs are eligible to enter.

The top ten scoring dogs from the first round will compete in the final and we offer:

First: \$500, perpetual trophy, trophy to keep, embroidered dog rug and a bag of Dogpro Plus

Second: \$300, trophy and a bag of Dogpro Plus Third: \$200, trophy and a bag of Dogpro Plus Fourth: \$100, trophy and a bag of Dogpro Plus Fifth: \$50, trophy and a bag of Dogpro Plus

Entry fee is \$15 per dog.





* Depending on the number of entries received, the Novice class of the State Championships may begin on Friday, October 11. We also offer special trophies for the:

- Best cast, lift and draw in the Open
- Fastest penning time in the Open
- Simmonds Family Trophy for the highest score gained by a Novice dog in the Open
- Highest score gained by an Improver dog in the Open
- Highest aggregate gained by three nominated dogs in the Open. You may nominate more than one group of dogs for this trophy.

Entry for all of the special trophies above is free – please indicate any eligible dogs on your entry form.

Competitors please note

- These events will be run on the modified South Australian course and under the rules of the SAWSDA.
- Payment by a competitor for entry into these trials is an indication of their acceptance of the SAWSDA Constitution, Regulations and Rules, including the Code of Conduct, which is applicable to all activities and areas of the venue. - Competitors must be financial members of the Working Sheepdog or Yard Dog Association in the State in which they reside and their dogs must be registered as required by that Association.
- The Council of the SAWSDA Inc. reserves the right to refuse the entries from any person whose conduct or comments are deemed to be detrimental to this competition or to the Association.
- Bitches in oestrus will be permitted to compete. We would appreciate your consideration in keeping them isolated from other competitors' dogs whenever possible.
- Each trial duration is a maximum of fifteen minutes.
- Novice and Improver dogs are eligible to compete in the State Championships. They will have one run only in the Open class – there is not a separate Improver class.
- The winning of any of the special trophies listed above will not be deemed as winning a trial and will not affect the status of a Novice or Improver dog.
